

MARICOPA COUNTY DOG LICENSE

Get or renew dog license here: <https://www.maricopa.gov/226/Dog-License>

Your adopted dog will need to have a current license from Maricopa County Animal Care and Control.

- Puppies that have not received their Rabies Vaccination (usually less than 18 weeks old) or a dog that was not previously licensed will need to be registered with Maricopa County.
- They have an online registration service or fill out the application provided on their website – www.maricopa.gov/pets

Some dogs are owner surrendered and were previously licensed.

- For those pets, you will need to change the license ownership to reflect your information, they will be identified by the adoption counselor at the time of adoption.

Please go online at www.maricopa.gov for all rules and guidelines required by Maricopa County related to pet licenses.

Altered dogs will cost \$21.00 to be licensed.

When applying for a dog license for the first time, you will need the following information:

- Completed Rabies Vaccination Certificate including:
- Owner's name and address
- Pet Information (name, breed, color, age, etc.)
- Date that the Rabies Vaccination was administered
- Manufacturer and serial/lot number of the vaccination used
- Term of the vaccination or date revaccination is due
- Veterinarian hospital/clinic where your dog was vaccinated
- Veterinarian's ID/License number and signature that administered the vaccination
- Visa, American Express, Discover, or MasterCard number and expiration date.
